**USGA RULES SHALL GOVERN ALL PLAY WITH THE FOLLOWING LOCAL RULES IN EFFECT:**

**PENALTY AREAS (Rule 17): HOLE #10:** The penalty area to the left of the fairway is deemed to be entirely a "Red" penalty area when playing #10. **HOLE #11:** The penalty area is deemed to be entirely a "Yellow" penalty area when playing hole #11. **HOLE #18:** The penalty area to the left of the fairway is deemed to be entirely a "Red" penalty area when playing hole #18.

**DEFINITION OF BOUNDARIES AND MARGINS:**

**Out of Bounds:** Defined by the inside edge, at ground level, of fence posts of both chain link and wood fencing and/or white stakes.

**Penalty Areas:** Defined by either red or yellow stakes or lines.

**Ground Under Repair:** Defined by white lines.

**CART PATHS:** Paved and graveled cart paths are considered immovable obstructions and relief is granted according to Rule 16.1 (Immovable Obstructions).

**STAKED TREES:** Young or fragile trees may be identified by stakes. If such a tree interferes with a player's stance or intended area of swing, the ball may be lifted, without penalty and dropped in accordance with the procedure in Rule 16.1. (Immovable Obstructions).

**BALL DROP AREA:** If a ball comes to rest in the penalty area while playing Hole #11, the player may, as an additional option under Rule 17, drop a ball in the ball drop area located adjacent to the green tee area.

**OUT OF BOUNDS:** (Rule 18) The clubhouse area behind the #9 & #18 greens is defined as out of bounds by the inside edge of the concrete curbing and the asphalt paved surfaces.

**DISTANCE MEASURING DEVICES:** Devices that measure distances only will be allowed for all rounds including tournament play. However, the use of devices that gauge or measure other conditions that might affect a player's play (e.g. slope, wind or gradient) are not permitted. Rule 4.3.

**IMMOVABLE OBSTRUCTIONS CLOSE TO PUTTING GREEN:** Relief from interference by an immovable obstruction may be taken under Rule 16.1. The player also has these extra options to take relief when such immovable obstructions are close to the putting green and on the line of play: The player may take relief under Rule 16.1b if an immovable obstruction is on the line of play and is within two club-lengths of the putting green and within two club-lengths of the ball. Exception: There is no relief under this local rule if the player chooses a line of play that is clearly unreasonable.
